- Please note, you will be obliged to sign on first prior to entering the track.
- Full Racing gear.

3 COMPETITOR ELIGIBILITY

- Be a WOMZA OVAL RACING COMMISSION **APPROVED QUALIFIER**.
- Competitor must have raced 3 WOMZA club events and a NQ to qualify for an entry into the Nationals.
- No one day licenses permitted.
- Competitors are also reminded that it is not the duty of any of the officials to ensure compliance.
- Competition Numbers on vehicles must comply with regulation and be easily visible to enable scoring and administration.
- It shall remain the responsibility of the competitor to check the racing WhatsApp group/ Notice board to establish their grid position furthermore, they shall familiarize themselves with the race formats.
- Competitors who are not in their correct grid positions on the track, when the starting flag is drop shall forfeit all rights to oppose their incorrect positions.

WOMZA in concert with the officials and promotor shall have the controlling rights to amend a regulation, in the interest of the sport and to ensure fair competition.

5 DRAWS FOR HEATS

- Will take place in the Perdeklubhuis.
- GRR 10.1.1 The grid positions will be determined by a draw system.
- GRR 10.1.3 Positions drawn determines Heat 1, the 2nd heat being the pole invert of heat 1. Heat 4 being the pole invert of heat 3 and the finals the total points earned in scored heats.
- One (1) non penalized heat can be dropped to score for the final starting.

6 SCORING

- 1st, 20, 2nd 19 reducing by one.
- The total points for three heats and the final will determine the final position for the event and the trophies.

7 NUMBER OF LAPS

- Minimum of 15 laps per heats and finals.
- In the event of a class reducing to 10 or less starters for the final grid the laps will reduced to 12 laps.
- Organizers reserves their rights to amend the proposed time table schedule or delete heats in the interest of the program running late after 24H00.

8 ADDITIONAL STARTER ORDERS

- Race damage vehicles to be scrutineered and signed off prior to being allowed back on track to commence the following heats.

9 GATE ENTRY

Gate 7 Spectators - Open - 10h00

- Only Spectators
- NO Race cars will be allowed to enter at this gate.

- NO Official, Marshal or VIP Member to enter at this gate.

Gate 8 Documentation - Friday - 10h00 - 16H00

Competitors:

- Produce your competition license.
- Produce proof of entry paid.
- Sign on into the correct class you intend participating in.
- Driver entering more than one class must make sure to sign in for all the classes he/she intends to compete.
- Ensure you obtain your Scrutineer page, which is to be handed to the Scrutineer.
- Competitors to list their pit crew.
- Ensure you receive your Pit Sticker for access into the Pits.
- Ensure you receive your Pit wristband for access into the Pits.

Pit Crew

- Pay the normal entry fee of the day.

Scrutineering - Open Area - Friday - 10H15 - 16H15

- Scrutineering will be done in the open area on the right-hand side of the main entrance, after the documentation has been done.
- Full race gear to be presented at scrutineering.
- All trailers to be left in the scrutineering area.
- Only one service vehicle and race car will be allowed in the pit area.
- Please ensure all your spares, tyres etc are in the service vehicle.

Marshals, Officials and VIP Members

- Fully detailed list will be used to control entries
- Only 1 Official and 1 companion permitted to enter for free, as long as everyone is in the same vehicle: and to enter in pits.

Competitor representative and video footage

- Clubs to appoint competitors' representative who shall sign on the official register to represent the competitor at the COC, at all times in the event of grievances or penalties or warning flags.
- Only track video footage will be for official use only.

Gate 9 Next to the Barn Pub - Open - 10H00

- Only Spectators
- NO Race cars will be allowed to enter at this gate.
- NO Official, Marshal or VIP Member to enter at this gate.

10 PIT REGULATIONS

- Competitors and their crew are to obey all pit rules.
- It is important to note that competitors and crew only become entitled to pit entry once
- their vehicle has passed scrutiny.
- Competitors are reminded that they are responsible for the conduct of their family and pit crew.
- Competitors are requested to heed instructions given by the pit marshals.
- No unauthorized person in the pit area.
- No Private cars in the pit area.
- No trailers will be permitted in the pits.
- Box Trailers will be directed to a designated area, due to a lack of space in the usual pit area.
- No loading during the race inside the pits. You may load outside in the trailer-park.
- No Spinning allowed in the pit area.
- No passengers in or on the Race car while driving.
- No smoking allowed in the pit area.
- No open fires or gas braais.
- Alcohol prohibited.

11 GENERAL

11.1 Club Reps

- Each Club to appoint a Club Representative.
- Club Reps to sign on at documentation.
- Club Reps refrain from any form of altercations, they may not enter other club competitors pit areas.
- Club Rep to try and resolve matters with competitor after a heat.
- Club Rep may not address the Officials on their own in the absence of the competitor.
- Club Rep together with the competitor shall address the COC only.
- Club Reps do not replace a parent/guardian for minor competitors, the parent/guardian and competitor to accompany the Club Rep.
- Club Reps shall address matters in the most amicable manner, unruly behaviour may result in the competitor they were representing to be excluded.
- Club Reps not permitted to consume alcohol – breathalysers tests may be requested by the officials.

11.2 Infield and Driver's Briefing

- **Infield** Competitors failing to attend drivers briefing or being late, can be excluded from the event.
- All cars park on the infield in preparation for the grand parade. Parade to be done, city-by- city {club by club} please bring your banners.

- No crew or unauthorized persons are allowed on the infield.
- No passengers are permitted during parades.
- Competitors are to advise their pit crew or family members, that should a competitor be involved in an accident the permission of the COC only is required to enter on track.

11.3 Weighing of Vehicles

- Once the event has commenced the officials are entitled to weigh a vehicle at any time during the event and the vehicle must be compliant.

11.4 Notice board

- It shall remain the responsibility of the competitor to check the WhatsApp/ Notice board to establish their grid positions, furthermore they shall familiarize themselves with the race formats and or methods in which the organizers use to replace notice boards of the event.
- Please also see the Supplementary Regulation Amendments attached if any.
- Once racing has been concluded it will be removed to the prizegiving hall.

12 PROTEST

- Protest fees – R2000
- Appeal fees – R3000

13 VEHICLE COMPLIANCY

- As per WOMZA. GRR and Technical, regulations.

14 PRIZEGIVING

Trophies and Prizegiving - Function Hall - one hour after the race

- The trophies and awards presented at this event are awarded by WOMZA.
- The competitor is responsible for advising who will be collecting the trophy on their behalf.
- Please note that competitors will only be excused for the most compelling reasons.
- All competitors, their families and pit crew members are welcome to attend. Seating is strictly on a first come, first-served basis.
- Competitors are advised that the prizegiving is still part of the event and any misconduct will be dealt with accordingly and regarded as a very serious offence.
