ELIGIBILITY AND PRE-START REQUIREMENTS:

Competitors eligible to take part in the event must be in possession of a <u>valid WOMZA</u> Oval Race License. It's the competitor's responsibility to have a valid Womza License. All vehicles must comply with WOMZA class requirements as at date of event.

4. ENTRIES

4.1 Entries are open.

All competitors to enter on or before 26/10/2025 to qualify for Class entries. Nationals and supporter classes. If there is enough entries in the supporter classes (MIN 8) before 26/10//2025 the class will be allowed to race. Nationals class is restricted to a minimum of 15 entries per class to enjoy Championship status. WOMZA reserve the right to increase or decrease the starters in the interest of the sport.

4.2 Entry Fees:

Entry FEE for SUPPORTER classes R100 per entry. Entry FEE for Nationals classes R750-00

8. **GENERAL**

- 8.1 <u>Pit Area:</u> No private cars will be allowed into the pit area. All Trailers are to be left in allocated Trailer parking. No unauthorized vehicles will be allowed into the pit area. No alcohol will be allowed in the pit areas. The Designated smoking area is in front of the Race Office. Seating and Pit Parking will be allocated to drivers.
- 8.2 Signals: Flags as per WOMZA GRR25.
- 8.3 Accidents, Retirements, Protest and Appeals:

Retirement must be reported to the Event Secretary/ Lap scorers without delay.

Protest forms are available from the Race Secretary and the competitor concern must submit protest within the time limits. Refer to GRR 29 – GRR 35 of the WOMZA Handbook.

8.4 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHP SCORING - as per the amended National Champ Regs

- 7.1 Points for qualifying will be 10,9,8,7,6,5,4,3,2 with each qualifier from 10th position downwards receiving 1 point.
- 7.2 Points for Heats will be 30,29,28,27,26 down to 1 point for each Competitor who finishes 30th or lower.
- 7.3 Combined scores from Qualifying and Heats will determine Grid for Final. Any ties will be broken by Qualifying position.
- 7.4 The final heat shall score, 1st-30, 2nd-29, 3rd-28 reducing one instead of 1,2,3, over the finish line as the GRR's do not make provision for point penalties by using the system 1,2,3 over the finish line. After the final heat has been run by the issue of points in the final heat, authorises the officials to take action accordingly as per the GRR by way of point penalties which could affect a breaching competitor in the final heat.

SUPPORTER CLASSES ONLY

Heat 1: Draw for Pole Position.

Heat 2: Invert of Heat 1

Final Heat: Most Points scored in Heat 1 and 2 = Pole for Final Heat. Total Laps for heats = Total starters plus 2 (or per COC discretions)

Support classes Trophies – H1, H2 and Final points added together and highest point scorer takes the win, 1^{st} , 2^{nd} , 3^{rd}

Club members - Appearance points: Each club member who enter the day to race will receive 5 Points toward their club points.

GRIDS WILL BE COMMUNICATED ON WHATSAPP AND NOTICE BOARD AT OFFICE

7.5 Grid Positions, Scoring & Results: (GRR 23.7)

Draws: Draws will take place on Race Day at the BOARDROOM. All competitors to Sign on and pay AT THE GATE before Draws take place.

Heat 1: Draw, Heat 2: Invert of Heat 1, Final Heat: Most Points Pole

7.6 **The Results:** The final results of the event will be available in the Race office and Final Results will be posted on WHATSAPP GROUP before Prize Giving function.

PS: It is every competitor's own **responsibility** to check his/her own Results **before** the Final Heat Starts and **before** Prize Giving starts. Only the competitor may enter race office to check his/her Results.

7.7 TIES: Refer to GRRs for Ties

7.8 **Postponement, Abandonment or Cancellation:**

This meeting will not be cancelled, postponed or abandoned **without** the consent of WOMZA and/or Event Director/s. In the event of Force majeure, its STAR Raceway discretion host the event on another day.
