RACE ENTRIES – open immediately and closes the October 15, 2024

2.1 RACE ENTRY FEES:

- Strictly only online entries will be received
- R300 per competitor per class, includes 1 Pitmac Tickets at no charge
- Late entries received after the 15 October 2024 is R600.
- Additional pit tickets are available at R120 per tickets for the day.



NB: Competitors may not share a vehicle, and one vehicle may not enter two or more classes.

2.3 PRACTICE FEES:

- ALL drivers – R250 per car. Practice will take place on Friday, 1st November 2024 from 16h00 till 20h00.
- Fees must be paid before or on 15 October 2024 – Platinum Raceway Bank Account.

2.4 GATE ADMISSION FEES:

- Only Competitor permitted free access, proof of entry to be shown at gate
- Entry fee per day: 0-5 free, 6 -12 R60, 12 and up R120
- Track parking – R350 per parking (3 x 3) – Wendy Kinnear 061 640 2208 to reserve.

NCD 3. COMPETITOR ELIGIBILITY

- Be in possession of a valid ANNUAL Womza oval track license – no one day licenses permitted
- Be a current paid up member of a Womza Dirt affiliated club.
- Competitor must have competed in the class they wish to enter for at least 60% of their club events 2023/2024 to qualify entry into the Nationals.
- Dirt clubs will commit in sending the top 5 competitors in each class to compete.
- Platinum Raceway in the event of a class not meeting the number of minimum entries, they will be permitted to fill a class using competitors from their region and who have at least raced 4 events in the same period, thereafter other regions will be afforded to fill – if the organizers are unable to full fill this requirement the class shall forfeit the National Championship for 2024.

- **No front wheel drive vehicles are permitted in the 2.1 on national level.**

The Promotor shall only be entitled to fill these positions if the competitor is experienced enough or possibly races alternatively at other dirt oval tracks.

WOMZA in concert with the officials and promotor shall have the controlling rights to amend a regulation, in the interest of the sport and to ensure fair competition.



NCD 4. PROGRAMME OF EVENTS:

FRIDAY 1st November 2024 Practice 16h00 to 20h00 for all competitors willing to practise, Competitors must sign on in the clubhouse prior to going out for practice – Practice identification will be given which is to be produced to the Marshal on duty at the pit gate – full race gear mandatory for practice.

Prizegiving – 1 hour after final and/or dependent on strip classes but not later than 2 hours

➤ No passengers permitted on grand parade other than the competitor sitting on the bonnet or standing securely on the side of the vehicle, with an adult driver.

NCD 5. DRAWS FOR HEATS:

5.1 Heat 1 & 2

14 and less, draw and invert

15 and more, 1/3 grid split A, B, C

5.2 Heat 3

14 and less, draw and invert

15 and more, 1/3 grid split A, B, C

5.3 Final Heat

- Final heat's Grid position determined by points for final heat.
- Discarding of poorest heat: Officials will discard the heat on behalf of the competitor.
- Heats with DNS / Disqualification or point penalty heats may not be discarded

SCORING:

- 1 st, 20, 2nd 19 reducing one

NCD 7.

NUMBER OF LAPS:

- All other classes minimum 15 laps in heats and maximum of 20 laps in the finals
NB: Class with less than 12 starters in the final will reduce to 15 laps

NCD 8. ADDITIONAL STARTER ORDERS:

- Competitors who do not start H1 (DNS) but start H2 will be sent Back of Pack, for the balance of the heats
- Competitors who have withdrawn from H1 and want to enter for H2, will start H3 BOP
- Race damage vehicles to be scrutineered and signed off prior to being allowed back on track to commence the following heats.

NCD 9. PIT REGULATIONS:

- Competitors and crew to obey pit rules.
- Competitors to list their pit crew before the day.
- Competitors allowed one ticket to gain Pit access, additional tickets to be purchased.
- Competitors and pit crew only become entitled to the pit entry once their vehicle has passed scrutineering.
- Vehicles who have failed scrutineering will not be entitled to park in the pits
- Pit crew to always wear identification, failing which the security will remove them from the pits.
- Only one Tow Vehicle permitted in the pits – tow vehicle to receive and display a sticker throughout the duration of the event.
- Trailers to be parked outside pit area, marked area.
- Competitors to advise organizers of Box Trailers as these will be advised to a demarcated
- No unauthorized persons allowed in the pits
- Competitors are reminded they are responsible for the conduct of their family and pit crew
- Competitors are requested to heed instructions given by the pit marshals
- No loading during the race inside the pits – you may load your vehicle outside the pits.
- No spinning allowed in the pit area
- No open fires or gas braais in the pits
- Alcohol prohibited in the pits



NCD 10. GENERAL

10.1 Club Reps

- Each Club to appoint a Club Representative
- Club Reps to sign on at documentation
- Club Reps refrain from any form of altercations, they may not enter other club competitors pit areas, no consumption of alcohol.
- Club Rep to try and resolve matters with competitor after a heat
- Club Rep may not address the Officials on their own in the absence of the competitor
- Club Rep together with the competitor shall address the COC only
- Club Reps do not replace a parent/guardian for minor competitors, the parent/guardian and competitor to accompany the Club Rep
- Club Reps shall address matters in the most amicable manner, unruly behaviour may result in the competitor they were representing to be excluded
- Club Reps not permitted to consume alcohol – Breathalyzer tests may be requested by the officials

10.2 Infield

- No crew or unauthorized persons allowed on the infield at any time
- Competitors are to advise their pit crew or family members, that should a competitor be involved in an accident the permission of the COC only is required to enter on track

10.3 Driver's Briefing

- Competitors failing to attend drivers briefing or being late on Saturday, – be ready to be excluded from the event.
- Saturday, Competitors arriving later than 13h00, be ready to be excluded from the event.
- After Drivers Briefing all communication will be made via WhatsApp (WA), this instruction is part of your entry and deemed mandatory.

10.4 Weighing of Vehicles

- Friday Only – Scales will be made available at scrutineering on the Friday, any underweight vehicles will be afforded the opportunity to increase their weights using correct ballast and be reweighed
- Vehicles to be weighed excluding fire extinguishers and fuel.
- Scrutineer to record each competitor's weight prior to heat 1.
- Once scrutineering times have closed the scales will no longer become available and will form part of the National process.
- Only the competitor will be present at the weigh area, minor competitors to include the parent/guardian (1 person only).



- Vehicles are weighed fluid free – e.g., Officials entitled to request competitor to drain fuel prior to the vehicle being weighed.
- Once the event has commenced the officials are entitled to weigh a vehicle at any time during the event and be compliant.

10.5 Protest and Video Footage viewing

- Competitors wishing to view video footage shall do so by completing an Incident Report together with a fee of R250 per view
- Protest fees – R2000
- Appeal fees – R3000

NCD 11. VEHICLE COMPLIANCY – POST EVENT CHECKS

- Top 5 highest scorers will be checked after the finals

NCD 12. PRIZEGIVING

- Trophies and ZA numbers are awarded to the first three competitors with the highest points accumulated over the event
