Documentation - Gate 8 - Friday - 10h00 - 16H00

- * Produce your competition license.
- * Produce proof of entry paid.
- * Sign on into the correct class you intend participating in.
- * Driver entering more than one class must make sure to sign in for all the classes he/she intends to compete.
- * Ensure you obtain your Scrutineer page, which is to be handed to the Scrutineer.
- * Ensure you receive your Pit Sticker for access into the Pits.
- * Ensure you receive your Pit wristband for access into the Pits.

Scrutineering - Open Area - Friday - 10H15 - 16H15

- * Scrutineering will be done in the open area on the right hand side of the main entrance, after the documentation has been done.
- * Full race gear to be presented at scrutineering.
- * All trailers to be left in the scrutineering area.
- * Only one service vehicle and race car will be allowed in the pit area.
- * Please ensure all your spares, tyres etc are in the service vehicle.

Pit Area Regulations

- * Competitors and their crew are to obey all pit rules.
- * It is important to note that competitors and crew only become entitled to pit entry once their vehicle has passed scrutiny.
- * Competitors are reminded that they are responsible for the conduct of their family and pit crew
- * Competitors are requested to heed instructions given by the pit marshals.
- * No unauthorized person in the pit area.
- * No Private cars in the pit area.
- * No trailers will be permitted in the pits.
- * Box Trailers will be directed to a designated area, due to a lack of space in the usual pit area.
- * No loading during the race inside the pits. You may load outside in the trailer park.
- * No Spinning allowed in the pit area.
- * No passengers in or on the Race car while driving.
- * No smoking allowed in the pit area.
- * No open fires or gas braai's.
- * Alcohol prohibited.

Infield

- * No crew or unauthorized persons are allowed on the infield at any time.
- * Competitors are to advise their pit crew and family members that should a competitor be involved in an accident, the exclusive permission of the COC is required, to enter on the track and not marshals or officials.

Draws

- * 15 and less, draw, pole invert
 - * above 15, 1/3 grid split - A,B,C
 - * R1, R2, R3 - every competitor gets a chance to compete against each other, other than the finals.
 - * 1/3 classes, when a competitor falls out, you simply move up in the line on your side, there will be no crossing over like in a draw and invert grid.

Point Scoring

- * All heats are scored as follow: 20 for 1st place reducing down one.
- * One heat is dropped to determine the final grid. No penalty heats can be dropped.
- * Highest point scorers from the heats determines the grid for the final grid.
- * Trophies will be given to the first three {3} competitors with the highest points accumulated over the heats and final.

Laps

- * Minimum of 15 laps per heats and finals.
- * In the event of a class reducing to 10 or less starters for the final grid the laps will reduced to 12 laps.
- * Organizers reserves their rights to amend the proposed time table schedule or delete heats in the interest of the program running late after 24H00.

- * All Classes have Dirt Champion status. No supporting classes.
- * WOMZA reserves their rights to amend the number of entries accordingly, should it so be deemed necessary.

Official Meeting - Perdeklub huis @ 12H30

- * Discussion between marshals and officials regarding the arrangements and smooth running of the event.

Driver's Briefing and Grand parade- Infield @ 16H30

- * All competitors must be present at the driver's briefing.
- * All cars park on the infield in preparation for the grand parade. Parade to be done, city-by-city {club by club} please bring your banners.
- * No crew or unauthorized persons are allowed on the infield.
- * No passengers are permitted during parades.

Notice Board

- * It shall remain the responsibility of the competitor to check the WhatsApp/ Notice board to establish their grid positions, furthermore they shall familiarize themselves with the race formats and or methods in which the organizers use to replace notice boards of the event.
- * Please also see the Supplementary Regulation Amendments attached if any.
- * Once racing has been concluded it will be removed to the prizegiving hall.

Eligibility - Competitor and Vehicle

- * Be in possession of a valid WOMZA licence.
- * Be a current paid-up member of WOMZA affiliated club.
- * Be a WOMZA OVAL Racing COMMISSION APPROVED QUALIFIER.
- * Be presented in a neat and tidy condition.
- * Competitors are also reminded that it is not the duty of any of the officials to ensure that vehicles comply with regulations.
- * Competition Numbers on vehicles must be easily visible to enable scorers to do their allotted duty.
- * It shall remain the responsibility of the competitor to check the racing WhatsApp group and Notice board to establish their grid position, furthermore they shall familiarize themselves with the race formats.
- * Competitors who are not in their correct grid positions on the track, when the starting flag is drop shall forfeit all rights to oppose their incorrect positions.
- * Competitor must have race in the class they wish to compete and earned 200 points to qualify an entry into the Nationals.

Competitor representative and video footage

- * Clubs to appoint competitors' representative who shall sign on the official register to represent the competitor at the COC, at all times in the event of grievances or penalties or warning flags.
- * Only track video footage will be for official use only.

Protest fees

- * The protest fees shall be R2000 - NO IOU'S Permissible.
- * Competitors are reminded of their right to protest and appeal.

Trophies and Prizegiving - Function Hall - one hour after the race

- * The trophies and awards presented at this event are awarded by WOMZA.
- * The competitor is responsible for advising who will be collecting the trophy on their behalf.
- * Please note that competitors will only be excused for the most compelling reasons.
- * All competitors, their families and pit crew members are welcome to attend. Seating is strictly on a first come, first-served basis.
- * Competitors are advised that the prizegiving is still part of the event and any misconduct will be dealt with accordingly and regarded as a very serious offence.
