# 3. Entries

- 3.1 Entries Open Immediately
- 3.2 Entry fee for Supporting Classes R100-00
- 3.3 Entry fee for National Classes R750-00
- 3.4 All entries for both National and Supporter classes close on 19 September 2025 @ 18:00
- 3.5 All competitors must be in the possession of a valid WOMZA Licence.
- 3.6 All vehicles must comply with WOMZA class requirements.

#### 4. Format

- 4.1 National Classes
- 4.1.1 Qualifying for points
- 4.1.2 Inverted draw for Heat 2
- 4.1.3 Final as per points for Qualifying, Heat 1, and Heat 2 with tie split by qualifying points
- 4.2 Support Classes
- 4.2.1 Draw for heat 1
- 4.2.2 Inverted draw for heat 2
- 4.2.3 Final as per points for Heat 1 & Heat 2

# 5. Qualifying

- 5.1 Qualifying sequence determined by draw for heat 1
- 5.2 Each competitor will receive 1 sighting lap and 3 qualifying laps. Only the quickest time counts.
- 5.3 Competitor unable to make their qualifying slot will not be able to qualify and will not score points for qualifying.
- 5.4 Where competitors set identical times the competitor who set the time first will enjoy the higher point score.
- 5.5 Where timing equipment failure affects a competitor's chance to set a lap the competitor will be afforded the opportunity to qualify at the end of the session or accept any time set prior to the failure.
- 5.6 Where the equipment failure renders the continuation of the session impossible the event will revert back to a draw and invert system.
- 5.7 Where the conditions change to such an extent during the session refer to 5.6 above.

#### 6. Laps National Classes

- 6.1 Laps for National classes will be 20 laps (Ninjas 12 Laps)
- 6.2 Final 25 laps, irrespective of the number of starters (Ninjas 15 laps)

# 7. Point Scoring

- 7.1 Points for qualifying will be 10,9,8,7,6,5,4,3,2 with each qualifier from 10<sup>th</sup> position downwards receiving 1 point.
- 7.2 Points for heats 30,29,28,27,26 down to 1 point for each competitor who finishes 30<sup>th</sup> or lower.
- 7.3 Combined scores from qualifying and heats will determine grid for final. Any ties will be broken down by qualifying position.
- 7.4 The first 3 competitors over the line in the final will be SA1, SA2 and SA3 (subject to reviewed incidents in the final and TC inspections).

#### 8. Eligibility

- 8.1 Clubs to enter competitors
- 8.2 Open to all annual licence holders who have purchased their licences prior to the 1st July 2025.
- 8.3 One event licences will not be taken into consideration in meeting the criteria.

#### 9. Entry Fee

- 9.1 Entry fee of R750-00 payable to the host club.
- 9.2 Entry allows 1 x competitor and 2 x pit crew free entry, everybody else pays.
- 9.3 TRANSPONDERS MANDATORY

# 10. Tyre Restrictions

- 10.1 Six (6) new tyres permitted in each class
- 10.2 TC panel will ensure tyres are marked

## 11. Awards

- 11.1 Fastest qualifier in each class to receive a trophy
- 11.2 WOMZA to award trophies and badges one hour after the event.
